4. Trade personnel registration

Please register at the conference registration area after 1.00pm on Tuesday 29 September. This area will be clearly indicated by appropriate signage. You will be given an access ID tag plus a complimentary conference dinner ticket for each trade space booked.

There are 33 metered car parks adjacent to the Christchurch Convention Centre. A further 140 metered car parks are available under the Crowne Plaza Hotel plus 96 public parks available in Peterborough Street. This parking is available all day and evenings.

9. Floor plan and allocation of stands

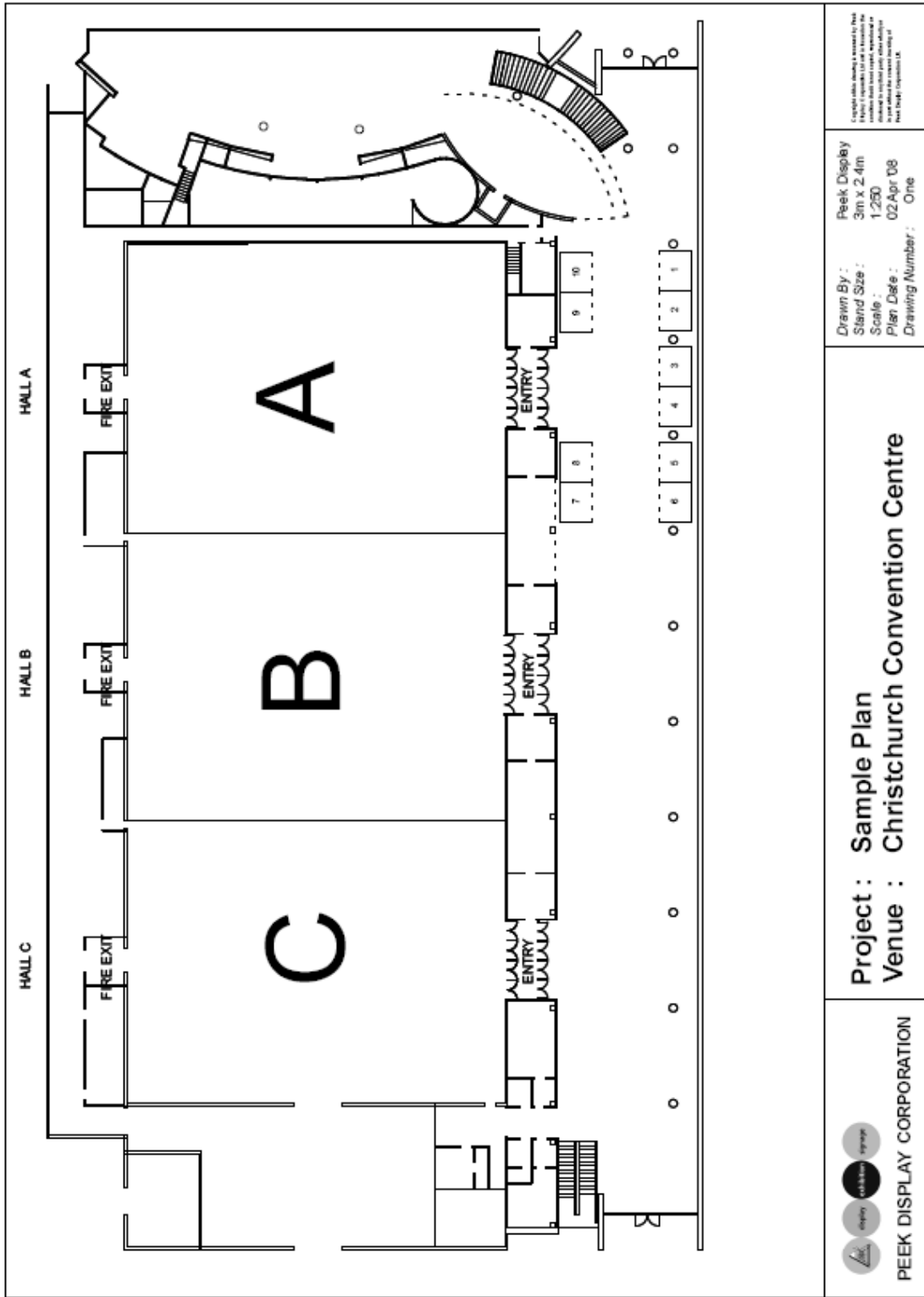
